In 2013, I was awarded a one-year fellowship by Indo US science and technology forum at National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke at National Institute of Health, Bethesda, USA in the field of Parkinson's disease and movement disorders under Dr. Mark Hallett. Currently I am working at Govind ballabh pant institute of postgraduate medical education and research (Formerly GB Pant Hospital), New Delhi as Professor Neurology and chief Parkinson's disease and movement disorder program. Contribution to neurological society of India: I have been regularly presenting research papers and invited talks during the annual conferences of neurological society of India. I am a regular reviewer for neurology India and also contributing large number of scientific papers, commentary and editorials for the publication in the journal. Contribution to neurosciences: I have done research in different fields of neurosciences and published more than 120 research papers including three Cochrane reviews.
